A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY ISSUES RELATED TO PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION FROM ALL CHILD DAY CARE HOME REGULATION FOR NEIGHBORS HELPING NEIGHBORS WITH CHILD CARE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study issues related to State registration or regulation of Child Day Care Homes. The Commission shall consider House Bill 1213 as originally introduced in the 1989 Session of the 1989 General Assembly as a part of this study. Sec. 2. The Commission shall report its findings, together with any recommended legislation, to the 1990 General Assembly. Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
