Section 1. Article 29 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 115C-403. Equal parental access to children at school.

Local boards of education shall adopt rules providing for parents' access to their children at school, including visiting and taking children from school. These rules may not discriminate between custodial and noncustodial parents. School personnel may not deny a parent access to his child to the extent authorized by the local board of education rules except pursuant to a court order prohibiting such access."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
