- Section 1. (a) Any legislative agent registered under Article 9A of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is requested to, while in the Legislative Building or in the Legislative Office Building, wear an identification tag giving that person's name and the words "Legislative Agent" or "Lobbyist".
- (b) Any reporter, whether for a newspaper, magazine, wire service, or radio or television station, is requested to, while in the Legislative Building or in the Legislative Office Building, wear an identification tag giving that person's name and the organization with which that person is employed or under contract as a reporter.
- (c) Any agency liaison is requested to, while in the Legislative Building or in the Legislative Office Building, wear an identification tag giving that person's name and the words "Agency Liaison".
- (d) Any member of the legislative staff is requested to, while in the Legislative Building or in the Legislative Office Building, wear an identification tag giving that person's name and the words "Legislative Staff".
 - Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
