nursing homes:

(1) The placement and adequacy of the regulatory process for domiciliary homes;

issues concerning care provided by rest homes, intermediate care facilities, and skilled

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the following

- (3) The need to have mandatory independent nursing home preadmission screening regardless of assets and income levels to encourage appropriate use of alternative community based care;
 - (4) Follow-up of the implementation of the Omnibus Reconciliation Act of 1987 on the nursing home industry within the State;
 - (5) Separation of residents with severe mental illness from the frail elderly in domiciliary homes;
 - (6) The need to increase reimbursement rates for facilities that serve patients with special needs; and
- 22 (7) A registry that would allow nursing home and domiciliary home administrators to check the criminal record of potential aides.
