| (1) | The location of all facilities and their bed capacity; |
| (2) | The violations cited against each long-term care facility and dates of |
| (2) | these violations; |
| (3) | The current owner of the facility; |
| (4) | The start-up date of the facility; |
| (5) | The acuity level of the patients; |
| (6) | The number of patients for whom the public pays and the number who |
| (7) | are private paying patients, in each facility; |
| (7) | The administrative penalties assessed against each long-term care |
| (0) | facility and the dates of these penalties; and |
| (8) | All other data necessary to assess the adequacy of care provided by the |
| | State's long-term care facilities. |

- The Department shall make a report containing all the data it has collected to the General Assembly by June 1, 1990.
