1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR COMPLIMENTARY FISHING LICENSES FOR  
3 RESIDENTS OF REST HOMES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 113-271(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) The hook-and-line fishing licenses issued by the Wildlife Resources  
7 Commission are as follows:

8 (1) Repealed by Session Laws 1979, c. 830, s. 1.

9 (1a) Resident Sportsman Combination License – \$40.00. This license is  
10 valid only for use by an individual resident of the State.

11 (1b) Resident comprehensive fishing licenses valid only for use by  
12 individual residents of the State:

13 a. One day – \$10.00.

14 b. c. Repealed by Session Laws 1987, c. 156, s. 8.

15 d. Annual – \$25.00.

16 (1c) Lifetime Sportsman Combination Licenses – These licenses are valid  
17 only for use by individual holders and are of the following types  
18 depending on the holders' ages on the dates of issue.

19 a. Type I available only to an individual under one year of age  
20 – \$200.00.

21 b. Type Y available only to an individual under 12 years of age  
22 – \$350.00.

23 c. Type A available to a resident individual of any age –  
24 \$500.00.

- 1                   d.       Type N available to a nonresident individual of any age –  
2                               \$1,000.
- 3           (2)     Resident Combination Hunting-Fishing License – \$20.00. This license  
4                   is valid only for use by an individual resident of the State.
- 5           (2a)    Resident State Fishing License – \$15.00. This license is valid only for  
6                   use by an individual resident of the State.
- 7           (2b)    Lifetime Resident Comprehensive Fishing License – \$250.00. This  
8                   license is valid only for use by an individual resident of the State.
- 9           (3)     Resident County Fishing License – \$10.00. This license is valid only  
10                   for use by an individual resident of the State within the county in  
11                   which he resides.
- 12           (4)     Resident one-day State fishing license valid only for use by an  
13                   individual resident of the State during the day indicated: – \$5.00.  
14                   a.-c. Repealed by Session Laws 1987, c. 156, s. 8.
- 15           (4a)    Nonresident Sportsman Combination License – \$130.00. This license  
16                   is valid for use by an individual within the State.
- 17           (4b)    Nonresident comprehensive fishing licenses valid for use by an  
18                   individual within the State only during the day, consecutive days, or  
19                   year indicated:  
20                    a.       One day – \$15.00.  
21                    b.       Three days – \$25.00.  
22                    c.       Repealed by Session Laws 1987, c. 156, s. 8.  
23                    d.       Annual – \$50.00.
- 24           (5)     Nonresident State Fishing License – \$30.00. This license is valid for  
25                   use by an individual within the State.
- 26           (6)     Nonresident variable short-term State fishing licenses which are valid  
27                   only for use by an individual within the State during the day or  
28                   consecutive days indicated at the following rates:  
29                    a.       One day – \$10.00.  
30                    b.       Three days – \$15.00.  
31                    c.       Repealed by Session Laws 1987, c. 156, s. 8.
- 32           (7)     Lifetime Fishing License for the Legally Blind – No charge. This  
33                   license is valid only for use by an individual resident of the State who  
34                   has been certified by the Department of Human Resources as a person  
35                   whose vision with glasses is insufficient for use in ordinary  
36                   occupations for which sight is essential. This license is valid for the  
37                   life of the individual so long as he remains legally blind.
- 38           (8)     Disabled Veteran Lifetime Combination Hunting-Fishing License –  
39                   \$7.50. This license is valid only for use by an individual resident of the  
40                   State who is a fifty percent (50%) or more disabled war veteran as  
41                   determined by the Veterans Administration. The license is valid for the  
42                   life of the individual so long as he remains fifty percent (50%) or more  
43                   disabled.
- 44           (9)     [Reserved.]

- 1           (10) Age 70 Lifetime Combination Hunting-Fishing License – \$10.00. This  
2           license is valid only for use by an individual resident of the State who  
3           has attained the age of 70 years. The license is valid for the life of the  
4           individual.
- 5           (11) Totally Disabled Resident Combination Hunting-Fishing License –  
6           \$7.50. This license is valid only for use of an individual resident of the  
7           State who is totally disabled (physically incapable of being gainfully  
8           employed). This license is valid for the life of the individual so long as  
9           he remains totally disabled.
- 10          (12) Rest Home Resident Fishing License – No charge. This license is valid  
11          only for use of an individual resident of the State who resides in a  
12          domiciliary home as defined in G.S. 131E-101(4). This license is valid  
13          for the life of the individual so long as he remains a resident of a  
14          domiciliary home."
- 15          Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
