Code and all other applicable State and local laws and local ordinances and regulations.

No permit may be issued unless the plans and specifications are identified by the name

and address of the author thereof; and if the General Statutes of North Carolina require

that plans for certain types of work be prepared only by a registered architect or

registered engineer, no permit may be issued unless the plans and specifications bear the

- North Carolina seal of a registered architect or of a registered engineer. If a provision 1 2 of the General Statutes of North Carolina or of any ordinance requires that work be 3 done by a licensed specialty contractor of any kind, no permit for the work may be issued unless the work is to be performed by such a duly licensed contractor. No permit 4 issued under Articles 9 or 9C of G.S. Chapter 143 shall be required for any construction, 5 6 installation, repair, replacement, or alteration costing five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less in any single-family residence or farm building unless the work involves: the 8 addition, repair or replacement of load bearing structures; the addition (excluding 9 replacement of same size and capacity) or change in the design of plumbing; the 10 addition, replacement or change in the design of heating, air conditioning, or electrical wiring, devices, appliances, or equipment; the use of materials not permitted by the 11 12 North Carolina Uniform Residential Building Code; or the addition (excluding 13 replacement of like grade of fire resistance) of roofing. Violation of this section 14 constitutes a misdemeanor.
 - (b) No permit shall be issued pursuant to subsection (a) for any land-disturbing activity, as defined in G.S. 113A-52(6), for any activity covered by G.S. 113A-57, unless an erosion control plan has been approved by the Sedimentation Pollution Control Commission pursuant to G.S. 113A-54(d)(4) or by a local government pursuant to G.S. 113A-61 for the site of the activity or a tract of land including the site of the activity.
 - (c) A county may by ordinance provide that a permit may not be issued under subsection (a) to a person who owes delinquent property taxes, determined under G.S. 105-360, on property owned by the person."
 - Sec. 2. This act applies to Onslow County only.
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

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
