A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A 3 RESIDENTIAL STATE PARK RANGER TRAINING CENTER. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 5 Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the 6 7 sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the purpose of establishing a residential training center to improve the professional skills 8 9 and capabilities of State Park superintendents, rangers, and support staff.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
