A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACCRUAL OF INTEREST ON DAMAGES AWARDED UNDER THE STATE TORT CLAIMS ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 143-294.1. Accrual of interest on awards after hearing.
(a) When, in a tort claims case, a hearing or hearings have been held and an award made pursuant thereto, the State department, institution or agency shall pay interest on the final award from the date of the filing of the affidavit required by G.S. 143-297 until paid at the legal rate of interest provided in G.S. 24-1. The amount of interest shall not be restricted by the limitation on the amount of an award imposed by G.S. 143-291. (b) Interest not exceeding the amount payable under subsection (a) of this section may be paid but shall not be required where claims requiring review and approval of the Industrial Commission pursuant to G.S. 143-295 are settled."
Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply only to awards

made or settlements concluded on or after the effective date of this act.
