2 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE CALENDAR YEAR FOR THE ACCUMULATION OF

- ANNUAL LEAVE BY PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.
 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
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Section 1. G.S. 115C-285(a)(2) reads as rewritten:

6 Supervisors and classified principals paid on an hourly or other basis whether "(2) paid from State or from local funds may accumulate annual vacation leave days as 7 follows: annual leave may be accumulated without any applicable maximum until 8 December 31-June 30 of each year. On December 31-June 30 of each year, any supervisor 9 or principals with more than 30 days of accumulated leave shall have the excess 10 accumulation cancelled so that only 30 days are carried forward to January-July 1 of the 11 next-same year. All vacation leave taken by the employee will be upon the authorization 12 of his immediate supervisor and under policies established by the local board of 13 education. An employee shall be paid in a lump sum for accumulated annual leave not 14 to exceed a maximum of 240 hours when separated from service due to resignation, 15 dismissal, reduction in force, death, or service retirement. If the last day of terminal 16 leave falls on the last workday in the month, payment shall be made for the remaining 17 18 nonworkdays in that month. Employees retiring on disability retirement may exhaust annual leave rather than be paid in a lump sum. The provisions of this subdivision shall 19 be accomplished without additional State and local funds being appropriated for this 20 The State Board of Education shall adopt rules and regulations for the 21 purpose. 22 administration of this subdivision."

23 Sec. 2. G.S. 115C-302(a)(3) reads as rewritten:

Notwithstanding any provisions of this section to the contrary no person shall 1 "(3) 2 be entitled to pay for any vacation day not earned by that person. The first 10 days of 3 annual vacation leave earned by a teacher during any fiscal year period shall be 4 scheduled to be used in the school calendar adopted by the respective local boards of 5 education. Vacation days shall not be used for extending the term of employment of 6 individuals. Teachers may accumulate annual vacation leave days as follows: annual 7 leave may be accumulated without any applicable maximum until December 31-June 30 8 of each year. On December 31-June 30 of each year, any teachers with more than 30 9 days of accumulated leave shall have the excess accumulation cancelled so that only 30 10 days are carried forward to January-July 1 of the next-same year. All vacation leave taken by the teacher will be upon the authorization of his immediate supervisor and 11 12 under policies established by the local board of education. An employee shall be paid in 13 a lump sum for accumulated annual leave not to exceed a maximum of 240 hours when 14 separated from service due to resignation, dismissal, reduction in force, death, or service 15 retirement. If the last day of terminal leave falls on the last workday in the month, 16 payment shall be made for the remaining nonworkdays in that month. Employees 17 retiring on disability retirement may exhaust annual leave rather than be paid in a lump 18 sum. The provisions of this subdivision shall be accomplished without additional State 19 and local funds being appropriated for this purpose. The State Board of Education shall 20 adopt rules and regulations for the administration of this subdivision."

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Sec. 3. G.S. 115C-316(a)(3) reads as rewritten:

22 "(3) Notwithstanding any provisions of this section to the contrary no person shall be entitled to pay for any vacation day not earned by that person. The first 10 days of 23 24 annual leave earned by a 10- or 11-month employee during any fiscal year period shall 25 be scheduled to be used in the school calendar adopted by the respective local boards of education. Vacation days shall not be used for extending the term of employment of 26 27 individuals. Ten- or 11-month employees may accumulate annual vacation leave days as follows: annual leave may be accumulated without any applicable maximum until 28 29 December 31-June 30 of each year. On December 31-June 30 of each year, any of these 30 employees with more than 30 days of accumulated leave shall have the excess 31 accumulation cancelled so that only 30 days are carried forward to January-July 1 of the 32 All vacation leave taken by these employees will be upon the next-same year. 33 authorization of their immediate supervisor and under policies established by the local 34 board of education. An employee shall be paid in a lump sum for accumulated annual 35 leave not to exceed a maximum of 240 hours when separated from service due to 36 resignation, dismissal, reduction in force, death or service retirement. If the last day of 37 terminal leave falls on the last workday in the month, payment shall be made for the 38 remaining nonworkdays in that month. Employees retiring on disability retirement may 39 exhaust annual leave rather than be paid in a lump sum. The provisions of this 40 subdivision shall be accomplished without additional State and local funds being 41 appropriated for this purpose. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules and 42 regulations for the administration of this subdivision."

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Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
