A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT INTERFERING WITH PEAK-LOAD ELECTRICITY
MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-151.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(b2) It is unlawful for any unauthorized person to alter, by-pass, interfere with, or cut off any load management device, equipment, or system which has been installed by the electricity supplier for the purpose of limiting the use of electricity at peak-load periods."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
