

1 Whereas, there is currently no federal funding available to start new Retired
2 Senior Volunteer Programs; and

3 Whereas, there is a great need and demand for the Retired Senior Volunteer
4 Programs from local areas; Now, therefore,
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
7 Aging, Department of Human Resources the sum of three hundred thousand dollars
8 (\$300,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to fund Retired Senior Volunteer Programs
9 (RSVP), to be allocated as follows:

- 10 (1) Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to fund new Retired Senior
11 Volunteer Programs; and
12 (2) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to fund existing Retired
13 Senior Volunteer Programs.

14 The program guidelines and standards for programs funded under this act shall be in
15 accordance with requirements developed by the Department of Human Resources. The
16 Department of Human Resources shall consider requirements that would require local
17 matching funds for programs funded under this act.

18 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
