A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A FOREST WATERSHED

MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST IN THE NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL
EXTENSION SERVICE.

Whereas, water quality is of major importance and concern to the citizens of North Carolina; and

Whereas, forestry activities, particularly forest harvesting, can, if not done properly, cause excessive sedimentation and erosion; and

Whereas, the implementation of Best Management Practices (BMP's) for water quality can effectively reduce such problems from forest harvesting operations; and

Whereas, adoption and implementation of such Best Management Practices will require a significant informational/educational program with both landowners and loggers; and

Whereas, the North Carolina Agricultural Extension Service, Forest Resources Department is a recognized leader in implementing such educational programs; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to provide a forest watershed management specialist in the
