A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PERMIT LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO REFUSE TO ISSUE ON-  
PREMISES MALT BEVERAGE LICENSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 105-113.71(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Local Exceptions. – The governing bodies of the following counties and cities in their discretion may decline to issue on-premises unfortified wine and on-premises malt beverage licenses: the Counties of Alamance, Alexander, Ashe, Avery, Chatham, Clay, Duplin, Granville, Greene, Haywood, Jackson, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Montgomery, Nash, Pender, Randolph, Robeson, Sampson, Transylvania, Vance, Watauga, Wilkes, Yadkin; any city within any of those counties; and the Cities of Greensboro, Aulander, Pink Hill, and Zebulon."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
