Section 1. G.S. 114-11.3 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 14-111.3. Making unneeded ambulance request in certain counties.

7 It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to willfully obtain or attempt to obtain 8 ambulance service that is not needed, or to make a false request or report that an 9 ambulance is needed. Every person convicted of violating this section shall upon 10 conviction be punished by a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment not to exceed 11 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment.

This section shall apply only to the Counties of Ashe, Buncombe, Cherokee, Clay,
Davie, Duplin, <u>Greene</u>, Haywood, Hoke, Macon, Madison, Robeson, Washington,
Wilkes and Yadkin."

15 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to 16 offenses occurring on or after that date.
