1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW MEMBERS OF WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITIES TO APPOINT MEMBERS OF THEIR OWN GOVERNING BOARD TO THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE AUTHORITY, AND TO ALLOW NONVOTING MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY.

Whereas, there is a concern about whether there is statutory authority for member governments to appoint members of their own governing boards to the board of a water and sewer authority, given the common-law rule that a board may not appoint one of its own members to public offices; and

Whereas, there is an interest in allowing the articles of incorporation of a water and sewer authority to provide for nonvoting members; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

# "§ 162A-3.2. Membership.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, organizing political subdivisions of a water and sewer authority may appoint members of their own governing boards as members of the authority.
- (b) The articles of incorporation of an authority organized under this Article may provide that some of the members of the authority are nonvoting members. Any water and sewer authority organized under this Article may amend its articles of incorporation with the approval of the governing boards of all the organizing political subdivisions, except for those which have withdrawn under G.S. 162A-4 and including any which

- have joined under G.S. 162A-4, so as to provide that some of the members of the authority are nonvoting members." 1
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 3
