A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CATAWBA COUNTY COUNCIL
FOR THE ARTS, INC., FOR ITS AFFILIATE ORGANIZATIONS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Catawba County Council for the Arts, Inc., the sum of \$175,213.35 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be allocated, as set out in subsection (b) of this section, among the following:

- (1) The Arts Center of Catawba Valley, Inc., for building repairs and improvements;
- (2) The Western Piedmont Symphony - The Unifour Orchestra, Inc., for office and music equipment;
- (3) The Hickory Museum of Art, Inc., for conservation of paintings;
- (4) The Catawba County Historical Association, Inc., for restoration and improvements of Murray's Mill and the Bunker Hill Bridge;
- (5) The Hickory Landmarks Society, Inc., for repairs and improvements to the Propst House; and
- (6) The Hickory Community Theatre for restoration of the facade of the old City Hall.

(b) Funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act shall be divided among the above-named entities by the Catawba County Council for the Arts, Inc., in proportion to the following requests for funds by those entities:

- (1) \$40,962.35 for the Arts Center of Catawba Valley, Inc.;
- (2) \$9,250 for the Western Piedmont Symphony - The Unifour Orchestra, Inc.;

- 1 (3) \$40,000 for the Hickory Museum of Art, Inc.;
- 2 (4) \$40,000 for the Catawba County Historical Association, Inc.;
- 3 (5) \$15,620 for the Hickory Landmarks Society, Inc.; and
- 4 (6) \$20,000 for the Hickory Community Theatre.
- 5 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
