**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SEASON FOR TAKING FOXES BY TRAPPING IN  
EDGECOMBE COUNTY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for taking foxes by trapping from January 2 or the last day of deer season, whichever is later, through January 31 of each year.

Sec. 2. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.

Sec. 3. A bag limit of 30 applies in the aggregate to all foxes taken during the fox season established in this act.

Sec. 4. This act shall apply only to Edgecombe County.

Sec. 5. This act shall become effective October 1, 1990.
