A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO SUSPEND THE OPERATION OF AN ANNEXATION ORDINANCE
OF THE TOWN OF ANDREWS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The operation of an annexation ordinance of the Town of Andrews, which was affirmed by the North Carolina Court of Appeals in the case of Adams v. Town of Andrews, in an opinion filed October 3, 1989, is suspended from July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1992. The statutory requirements of Part 2 of Article 4A of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes relating to provision of services after an annexation shall apply again to that area as of June 30, 1992, and any timetables imposed by that Article shall begin running anew as of June 30, 1992, as if that had been the initial effective date of the ordinance.

Sec. 2. This act does not affect liability for prorated property taxes levied for the 1989-90 fiscal year and payable as provided by G.S. 160A-58.10.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
