1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL FULL-TIME ASSISTANT DISTRICT
3 ATTORNEY IN JUDICIAL DISTRICT FIFTEEN-A AND TO APPROPRIATE
4 FUNDS FOR THE POSITION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each
8 district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth
9 in the following table:

40 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Justice  
 41 Department the sum of fifty-two thousand four hundred fifty-five dollars (\$52,455) for  
 42 the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of fifty-two thousand two hundred ninety-four  
 43 dollars (\$52,294) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to implement this act.

44 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
