2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
3 RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING HOSPITALS AND  
4 OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FOR ESSENTIAL INPATIENT AND  
5 OUTPATIENT HEALTH AND MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDED TO  
6 MIGRANT FARM WORKERS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS WHILE IN NORTH  
7 CAROLINA.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9       Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of  
10 Health Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of one hundred thousand  
11 dollars (\$100,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year, and the sum of one hundred thousand  
12 dollars (\$100,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to be used to reimburse hospital and  
13 other health care providers for essential inpatient and outpatient health and medical  
14 services provided to migrant farm workers and their dependents, to enable the Migrant  
15 Health Program adequately to address the farm workers' health needs during the peak  
16 harvest season, and to raise the reimbursement level of health care providers serving  
17 migrant farm workers.

18       Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
