A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR WINERY SPECIAL SHOW PERMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-1100 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(16) Winery Special Show Permit."

Sec. 2. Article 11 of Chapter 18B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

§ 18B-1120. Winery Special Show Permit.

The holder of an unfortified winery, fortified winery, or limited winery permit may obtain a winery special show permit which shall authorize the permittee to give free tastings and to sell the winery's products in the manufacturer's original unopened container at trade shows, conventions, wine festivals, or similar events approved by the Commission. No such permit shall be valid in any jurisdiction, unless the jurisdiction has approved ABC stores or the sale of unfortified wine.

Sec. 3. G.S. 18B-902 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(28) Winery Special Show Permit – \$100.00."

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
