1 A SENATE RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE
2 SENATE FOR THE 1989 SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY
3 REMOVING THE LIMITATION ON THE TYPES OF RESOLUTIONS WHICH
4 MAY BE INTRODUCED OR CONSIDERED.

5 Be it resolved by the Senate:

6 Section 1. Rule 40 of the Permanent Rules of the Senate for the 1989 Session
7 of the General Assembly reads as rewritten:

8 "RULE 40. **Introduction of bills.**—(a) Every bill filed for introduction shall
9 contain on the outside cover the title of the document and the name of the Senator or
10 Senators presenting it. Bills shall be delivered by the primary sponsor of the document
11 or with the prescribed authorization form signed by the primary sponsor to the office of
12 the Senate Principal Clerk who shall receive them during regular session according to
13 the following schedule:

14 Monday until 8:30 o'clock P.M.;

15 Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday until
16 4:00 o'clock P.M.;

17 Friday until 3:00 o'clock P.M.

18 All bills shall be numbered by the Office of the Principal Clerk when filed and shall be
19 considered introduced when presented to the Senate on the next following legislative
20 day for the first reading and reference to committee.

21 (b) Filing of bills during the interim shall be under the direction of the Rules and
22 Operation of the Senate Committee as approved by the Senate.

23 (c) ~~All memorializing, celebration, commendation, and commemoration~~
24 ~~resolutions, except those honoring the memory of deceased persons or honoring a North~~
25 ~~Carolina institution, shall be excluded from introduction and consideration in the~~
26 ~~Senate."~~
