There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 5 Cultural Resources for the Antique Village of Wilson County, Inc., the sum of one 6 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to renovate the former Lamm's Elementary School building and transform it into the Antique Exhibition Center of the South, a tourism project that would benefit the economy of Wilson County and 9 the State of North Carolina, provided local funds are raised by the Antique Village of 10 Wilson County, Inc., to match the State funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis. 11 12 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
