6	"(9) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this section, to
7	accept written appearances, waivers of trial and pleas of guilty in
8	violations of G.S. 14-399(c) and enter judgments in those cases as the
9	chief district court judge directs. No violation of G.S. 14-399 may be
10	disposed of pursuant to this subdivision unless the criminal pleading
11	specifically charges a violation of subsection (c) of G.S. 14-399."
12	Sec. 2. G.S. 7A-180 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
13	"(9) Has the power to accept written appearances, waivers of trial and pleas
14	of guilty to violations of G.S. 14-399(c), and, in such cases, to enter
15	judgments as the chief district court judge shall direct. No violation of
16	G.S. 14-399 may be disposed of pursuant to this subdivision unless the
17	criminal pleading specifically charges a violation of subsection (c) of
18	<u>G.S. 14-399.</u> "
19	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
