Section 1. G.S. 136-30 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- "(b1) When safety or other traffic conditions exist that require additional traffic control, a municipality may apply traffic control standards that are more stringent than those contained in the Uniform Manual and may place traffic signs and other traffic control devices to identify and enforce those more stringent standards."
 - Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Charlotte only.
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification. 14
