5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 22 of the Raleigh City Charter, Chapter 1184 of the 7 Session Laws of 1949, is amended by enacting a new subdivision to read:

- Cooperation with federal agencies. The City may enter into 8 "(85) contracts or agreements with any agency or department of the United 9 States Government in order to execute any undertaking. 10 Such contracts or agreements may involve activities carried out to benefit 11 a foreign government but the contract or agreement shall be with an 12 agency or department of the United States Government and shall 13 substantially comply with the requirements for interlocal agreements 14 set out in G.S. 160A-464." 15
- 16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification, but applies only to contracts or 17 agreements entered into prior to December 1, 1993.
