- 2 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO STUDY
- 3 AND RECOMMEND METHODS FOR ENCOURAGING STATE EMPLOYEES
- 4 TO USE PUBLIC TRANSIT IN COMMUTING TO WORK.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Department of Administration shall, in consultation with the 7 Department of Transportation, study and recommend methods for encouraging State 8 employees to use public transit, including carpools and vanpools, in commuting to 9 work. The Department of Administration shall report its findings and recommendations 10 to the 1993 General Assembly by March 15, 1993.

11 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
