CREDIT COMPARABLE TO THE FEDERAL INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR
CERTAIN EXPENSES INCURRED TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO DISABLED
INDIVIDUALS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may include in its study of
the revenue laws of this State the question whether the State should allow a business
that qualifies for a federal income tax credit under section 44 of the Internal Revenue
Code to receive a comparable State income tax credit.
Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
