6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by certain		
8	constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina	a, of the capital	
9	improvements projects listed in Section 2 of this act for each institution, and to		
10	authorize the financing of these capital improvements projects with funds available to		
11	the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds,		
12	or any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from the		
13	General Fund of the State.		
14	Sec. 2. The projects authorized to be constructed and financed as provided in		
15	Section 1 of this act are as follows:

7	Sec. 3. At the request of The University of North C	Carolina Board of	
8	Governors and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the		
9	Director of the Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the scope of or a change		
10	in the method of funding for any project authorized by this act. In making a		
11	determination of whether to authorize a change in scope or funding, the Director of the		
12	Budget may consult with the Advisory Budget Commission. I	n no event shall	
13	appropriations from the General Fund be used for a project authorized by this act.
