AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A FOSTER CARE REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TRAINING OF FOSTER PARENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of \$4,298,925 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$4,298,925 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to establish, in accordance with G.S. 108A-48, a foster care board rate of \$500.00 per month per child for children with special needs.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of \$209,658 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$209,658 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to provide foster care services training.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
