The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 143-215.1(b1) reads as rewritten: "(b1) The Commission shall adopt rules which exempt the filter backwash facilities of swimming pools and spas from the: Application and notice requirements of this section; <del>(1)</del> Reporting requirements of G.S. 143-215.65; 13 <del>(2)</del> Monitoring requirements of G.S. 143-215.66; and 14 (3)<del>(4)</del> Requirements of subsection (a) of this section that the Department review and approve of each individual facility." 16

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
