## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW RELATING TO THERAPEUTIC LEAVE FOR
- 3 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PATIENTS.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 108A-62 reads as rewritten:
- 6 "§ 108A-62. Therapeutic leave for medical assistance patients.

Patients at an intermediate care facility or skilled nursing facility may take up to 60 days of therapeutic leave in any <u>12-month period-one calendar year</u> without the facility losing reimbursement under the medical assistance program, provided, however, no more than <u>14-15</u> consecutive days may be taken without approval of the Department of Human Resources, Division of Medical Assistance."

12 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991, and applies to therapeutic 13 leave taken on and after that date.
