1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE REQUIREMENT THAT HUNTERS WEAR BLAZE
3 ORANGE TO ENCOMPASS THE HUNTING OF OTHER TYPES OF GAME.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 113-291.8(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Any person hunting bear, deer, or wild boar, game animals other than foxes,
7 bobcats, raccoons, and opossum, or hunting upland game birds other than wild turkeys,
8 with the use of firearms, must wear a cap or hat on his head made of hunter orange
9 material or an outer garment of hunter orange visible from all sides. Hunter orange
10 material is a material that is a daylight fluorescent orange color.

11 This section does not apply to a landholder, his spouse, or children, who are hunting
12 on land held by the landholder. This subsection shall be enforced by warning ticket only
13 until October 1, 1992, with respect to those hunting rabbit, squirrel, grouse, pheasant,
14 and quail."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
