A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE RECYCLING OF HAZARDOUS WASTE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 130A-294.1(1) reads as rewritten:	
"(l) A commercial hazardous waste storage, treatment, or disposal facility sh pay annually, in addition to the fees applicable to all hazardous waste storage, treatme or disposal facilities, a single tonnage charge of one dollar and seventy-five cer (\$1.75) per ton or any part thereof of hazardous waste stored, treated, or disposed of	nt, nts
the facility. A manufacturing facility that receives hazardous waste generated from to use of a product typical of its manufacturing process for the purpose of recycling exempt from this tonnage charge. A facility must have a permit issued under the Article which includes the recycling activity and specifies the type and amount of was	the is his

allowed to be received from off-site for recycling."
