A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING, WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA HOSPITALS AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by certain constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects listed herein for each institution, and to authorize the financing of these said capital improvements projects with funds available to the institutions and the Hospitals from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of such funds, but not including funds appropriated from the General Fund of the State.

- Sec. 2. The projects hereby authorized to be constructed and financed as provided in Section 1 of this act are as follows:
 - (1) East Carolina University
 - a. Old Cafeteria Renovation 5,124,300
- (2) North Carolina A & T State University
- a. Renovation of Five Residence Halls 6,915,900
- 21 (3) North Carolina State University at Raleigh
- 22 a. Campus Wide Telecommunications System 4,893,200
