1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF CASWELL BEACH TO ASSESS
3 BENEFITED PROPERTY FOR UNDERGROUNDING OF UTILITIES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 160A-216 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 160A-216. Authority to make special assessments.**

7 Any city is authorized to make special assessments against benefited property within
8 its corporate limits for:

9 (1) Constructing, reconstructing, paving, widening, installing curbs and
10 gutters, and otherwise building and improving streets;

11 (1a) Placing utility lines, including cable television lines, underground.

12 (2) Constructing, reconstructing, paving, widening, and otherwise building
13 or improving sidewalks in any public street;

14 (3) Constructing, reconstructing, extending, and otherwise building or
15 improving water systems;

16 (4) Constructing, reconstructing, extending, or otherwise building or
17 improving sewage collection and disposal systems of all types,
18 including septic tank systems or other on-site collection or disposal
19 facilities or systems;

20 (5) Constructing, reconstructing, extending, and otherwise building or
21 improving storm sewer and drainage systems."

22 Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Town of Caswell Beach.

23 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
