A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM FINE FOR VIOLATIONS OF CERTAIN NEW HANOVER COUNTY ORDINANCES AND OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITIES THEREIN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 118 of the 1983 Session Laws, is amended by deleting the phrase "Mecklenburg County." and substituting the phrase "the following counties: Mecklenburg and New Hanover."

- Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 71 of the 1983 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 772 of the 1987 Session Laws, is amended by deleting the phrase "Cities of Charlotte and Greensboro only." and substituting the phrase "only the following municipalities: the Cities of Charlotte, Greensboro, and Wilmington; and the Towns of Carolina Beach, Kure Beach, and Wrightsville Beach."
- Sec. 3. Section 3 of Chapter 71 of the 1983 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 772 of the 1987 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
- "Sec. 3. This act shall apply to the Cities of Charlotte and Greensboro only and shall—be applicable only to those ordinances which expressly provide that the maximum fine to be imposed for violation is some amount of money greater than fifty dollars (\$50.00). This act shall apply to the following municipalities only: the Cities of Charlotte,
- 20 Greensboro, and Wilmington; and the Towns of Carolina Beach, Kure Beach, and
- 21 Wrightsville Beach."

Sec. 4. This act is effective 60 days after ratification, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
