1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH 3 CAROLINA TO COORDINATE AND EXPAND EFFORTS IN RESEARCH. TEACHING, AND EXTENSION IN GERONTOLOGY. 4 Whereas, older citizens contribute significantly to the progress and general 5 6 well-being of our State and nation; and Whereas, The University of North Carolina presently carries out valuable 7 8 research, teaching, and extension activities in gerontology and related fields; and Whereas, The University of North Carolina needs to coordinate and expand 9 its efforts in research, teaching, and extension in gerontology; Now, therefore, 10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 11 12

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of \$100,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$100,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to provide funds to create the position of Gerontology Coordinator in the General Services Administration.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
