1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN **ACT** TO **APPROPRIATE** THE **FUNDS** TO DEPARTMENT OF 3 ADMINISTRATION TO HELP SUPPORT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION PROGRAMS AND CENTERS. 4

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Council on the Status of Women, the sum of \$1,801,516 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$1,801,516 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to support programs to prevent domestic violence and sexual assault to be allocated as follows:

- (1) Each of the 61 domestic violence centers in operation on January 1, 1991, and in operation on the date of the allocation, that offers services including a 24-hour hotline, transportation services, community education programs, daytime counseling services, and call forwarding during the night, shall receive a grant of \$30,000 each year of the 1991-93 biennium to be used for operation of the center.
- (2) Each of the 47 sexual assault programs in operation on January 1, 1991, and in operation on the date of the allocation, that offers services including a 24-hour hotline, transportation services, community education programs, daytime counseling services, and call forwarding during the night, shall receive a grant of \$30,000 each year of the 1991-93 biennium to be used for operation of the program.
- (3) The sum of \$150,000 in each year of the 1991-93 biennium to be used for start-up of additional programs to address problems of domestic

1	violence and of sexual assault; provided that not more than the sum of
2	\$30,000 may be granted to each new domestic violence and each new
3	sexual assault program that meets criteria established by the Council
4	on the Status of Women.
5	(4) The sum of \$30,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 and the sum of \$30,000 in
6	fiscal year 1992-93 shall be used for grants-in-aid of \$15,000 in each
7	fiscal year to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence,
8	Inc., and \$15,000 in each fiscal year to the North Carolina Coalition
9	Against Sexual Assault, Inc.
10	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
