6	Section 1. G.S. 87-21 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
7	"(<u>d1</u>) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, any resident of the State,	
8	upon submission	n of a license application and license application fee, shall receive a
9	license without	examination provided the applicant presents evidence to the Board that
10	<u>he:</u>	
11	<u>(1)</u>	Has not previously held a license in the area for which the application
12		<u>is made;</u>
13	<u>(2)</u>	Has engaged in the business of either plumbing or heating contracting
14		as defined in this Article for at least five years prior to July 6, 1971, in
15		any city, town, or other area in which this Article did not apply prior to
16		July 6, 1971; and
17	<u>(3)</u>	Has been continuously engaged, as a primary occupation, in plumbing
18		or heating contracting as defined in this Article.
19	In order to receive a license under this subsection, the applicant must submit a license	
20	application and license application fee and present all supporting evidence to the Board	
21	on or prior to December 31, 1991."
