A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PERMIT SPECIAL ABC PERMITS TO BE ISSUED FOR CERTAIN PRIVATE CLUBS AND PRIVATE LODGES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-1006 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(k) Special Private Club Permits. – The Commission may issue permits listed in G.S. 18B-1001 to qualified persons and establishments located within a private club located in a private development, without approval at an election, in any county with a population of less than 45,000 by the last federal census and in which there are at least three but not more than four cities located in that county and (i) only one city has an off-premises and on-premises malt beverage permit, (ii) at least two cities have an off-premises and on-premises fortified wine permit, and (iii) at least two cities have approved ABC systems in place on the ratification date of this section. The mixed beverages purchase-transportation permit authorized by G.S. 18B-404(b) shall be issued by a local board operating a store located in the county. A private club located in the county is defined as a club or lodge located in a privately owned, primarily residential and recreational development, which is open only to members by invitation of the club's board of directors and the guests of these members."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
