A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE CURRENT OPERATIONS APPROPRIATIONS
BILL INCLUDE THE FUNDS NEEDED FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR COVERED
BY THAT BILL TO FUND THE WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT
PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

**"§ 143-12.2. Water resources development funds in Current Operations
Appropriations Bill; funds do not revert.**

(a) The Director of the Budget shall include in the 'Current Operations
Appropriations Bill' submitted to the General Assembly the sum needed to fund the
Water Resources Development Program adopted under G.S. 143-215.73A for each
fiscal year covered by the bill. The Director of the Budget shall report separately to the
General Assembly the water resources development projects recommended for funding
by the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources that are not included
in the Water Resources Development Program and shall include in the report the
information provided by the Department on each of those projects.

(b) Funds appropriated for water resources development projects shall not revert
at the end of the fiscal period."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
