SENATE BILL 204

Short Title: Worker Training Trust Fund.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE WORKER TRAINING TRUST
2 FUND AND FROM THE SPECIAL EMPLOYMENT SECURITY
3 ADMINISTRATION FUND.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 96-5(f), there is
7 appropriated from the Worker Training Trust Fund to the following agencies the
8 following sums for the 1991-92 fiscal year and, unless otherwise stated, an equal
9 amount for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the following purposes:

- 10 (a) The sum of \$5,000,000 to the Employment Security Commission for
11 the operation of local offices at the 1986-87 level of service.
- 12 (b) The sum of \$1,960,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of
13 \$2,000,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to the North Carolina
14 Department of Economic and Community Development for a State job
15 training program to be administered through the Job Training
16 Partnership Act system aimed at the unemployed and the working
17 poor.
- 18 (c) The sum of \$250,000 to the North Carolina Department of Public
19 Instruction to establish five new Tech Prep programs in the public
20 schools.
- 21 (d) The sum of \$500,000 to the North Carolina Department of Labor for
22 customized training of the hard-core unemployed for specific jobs
23 needed by employers through the Department's Pre-Apprenticeship
24 Division.

1 (e) The sum of \$1,960,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of
2 \$2,000,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to the North Carolina
3 Department of Human Resources to assist welfare recipients in gaining
4 employment through the federally funded Job Opportunities and Basic
5 Skills program in such a way as to gain the maximum match of federal
6 funds for the State dollars appropriated.

7 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding G.S. 96-5(c), there is appropriated from the Special
8 Employment Security Administration Fund to the Employment Security Commission of
9 North Carolina, the sum of \$2,000,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of
10 \$2,000,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for administration of the Veterans Employment
11 Program, Employment Services Program, and Unemployment Insurance Program.

12 Sec. 3. Beginning October 1, 1991, each of the departments receiving funds
13 pursuant to Sections 1 or 2 shall report on a quarterly basis to the Joint Legislative
14 Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of these funds.

15 Sec. 4. Any portion of an appropriation in Section 1 of this act that is unspent
16 at the end of the fiscal year shall revert to the Worker Training Trust Fund and not to the
17 General Fund.

18 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
