(2)	The Board shall adopt regulations prohibiting the use of commercial
	chemicals of unknown content by persons registered under this
	Chapter. For purposes of this section, 'commercial chemicals' are
	those products sold only through beauty and barber supply houses and
	not available to the general public.
(3)	The Board shall adopt regulations instructing persons registered under
	this Chapter in the proper use and application of commercial chemicals
	where no manufacturer's instructions are included. In the alternative,
	the Board shall prohibit the use of such commercial chemicals by
	persons registered under this Chapter.
<u>(4)</u>	The Board shall adopt regulations requiring that cosmetology teachers
	complete a minimum of 16 hours of continuing education every two
	years. Effective October 1, 1993, the Board shall not renew the license
	of any cosmetology teacher who has not satisfied the continuing
	education requirements established by the Board.
<u>(5)</u>	The Board shall adopt regulations requiring that adequate ventilation
	be maintained in places where cosmetic art is practiced or taught.
	Regulations adopted under this subdivision shall be enforced no earlier
	than October 1, 1992."
