## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## 2 AN ACT TO IMPROVE PROCEDURES RELATING TO ACADEMICALLY 3 GIFTED STUDENTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-113(d) reads as rewritten:

6 The local educational agency shall furnish the results, findings, and "(d) 7 proposals, as described in the individualized education program or group educational program based on the diagnosis and evaluation to the parents or guardian in writing in 8 the parents' or guardian's native language or by their dominant mode of communication, 9 prior to the parent or guardian giving consent for initial placement in special education 10 and related services. Prior notice will be given to the parents or guardian by the local 11 educational agency before any change in placement. 12

A reevaluation must be completed at least every three years to determine the 13 appropriateness of the child's continuing to receive special education and related 14 15 services. services: Provided, that a reevaluation for an academically gifted child shall be completed within three years of initial evaluation for a child who has been identified as 16 academically gifted prior to the second semester of the third grade. For a child who is 17 identified as academically gifted during the second semester of the third grade or 18 thereafter, no reevaluation is required." 19

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and applies to require 20 reevaluations for children who have not reached the second semester of the third grade 21

22 by this date.
