Section 1. G.S. 153A-293 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 153A-293. Collection of fees in certain counties.

- (a) A county may provide that any fee imposed under G.S. 153A-292 may be billed with the ad valorem taxes, may be payable in the same manner as ad valorem taxes, and, in the case of non-payment, may result in the imposition of a lien on the property owner's real property in the same manner as ad valorem taxes.
- (b) This section applies to Alleghany, Anson, Ashe, Burke, Caswell, Cleveland, Duplin, <u>Franklin</u>, Gaston, Lee, Lenoir, Montgomery, Polk, Richmond, Robeson, Transylvania, Washington, Watauga, and Wayne Counties only."
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to fees imposed on or after July 1, 1991.
