- 5 TO DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION INMATES.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 148-19(d) reads as rewritten:

8 The Commission for Mental Health, Mental Retardation-Developmental "(d) Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services shall prescribe-adopt standards for the 9 delivery of mental health, mental retardation, and substance abuse health and mental 10 retardation services to inmates in the custody of the Department of Correction. The 11 Commission for Mental Health, Mental Retardation Developmental Disabilities, and 12 Substance Abuse Services shall give the Secretary of Correction an opportunity to 13 review and comment on proposed standards prior to promulgation of such standards; 14 however, final authority to determine such standards remains with the Commission. The 15 Secretary of the Department of Human Resources shall designate an agency or agencies 16 within the Department of Human Resources to monitor the implementation of such 17 18 standards by the Department of Correction. The Secretary of Human Resources shall send a written report on the progress which the Department of Correction has made on 19 the implementation of such standards to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, and the 20 21 Speaker of the House. Such reports shall be made on an annual basis beginning January 22 1, 1978."

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Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
