A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW INDUSTRY SPONSORED PERSONNEL TO ATTEND
EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS ON MILITARY BASES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 116-15(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Post-secondary Degree Activity within the Military. – To the extent that an institution undertakes post-secondary degree activity on the premises of military posts or reservations located in this State for military personnel stationed on active duty there, or their dependents, or industry sponsored personnel, the institution shall be exempt from the licensure requirements of this section."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
