AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A REDUCTION IN COSMETOLOGY FEES.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 88-21 reads as rewritten:

5	"§ 88-21.	Fees required.
---	-----------	----------------

- (a) The following fees shall be paid to the Board:
- (1) The fee to be paid by an applicant for a certificate of registration to practice cosmetic art as an apprentice shall be five dollars (\$5.00).-three dollars (\$3.00).
- (2) The fee to be paid by an applicant for an examination to determine his or her fitness to receive a certificate of registration as a registered cosmetologist shall be ten dollars (\$10.00). seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50).
- (3) The fee to be paid by an applicant for an examination to determine his or her fitness to receive a certificate of registration as a registered manicurist shall be five dollars (\$5.00). three dollars (\$3.00).
 - (4) The license fee for a registered cosmetologist shall be thirty-three dollars (\$33.00 twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00) for three years, payable in advance.
- 20(5)The fee for renewal of the license of a registered cosmetologist shall21be thirty-three dollars (\$33.00)-twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00) for three22years, payable in advance, if the license is renewed before it becomes23delinquent. The licenses of all registered cosmetologists shall be due24for renewal in October 1986, and every three years thereafter.

1	(6)	A delinquency penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid, in addition
2		to the renewal fee, for the renewal of a registered cosmetologist's
3		license that has become delinquent.
4	(7)	The annual fee for a registered apprentice or certified manicurist,
5		which shall be due on or before October 1, shall be five dollars
6		(\$5.00).
7	(8)	All cosmetic art shops shall pay an annual fee of three dollars (\$3.00)
8		two dollars (\$2.00) for each active booth, on or before February 1 of
9		each year.
10	(9)	A delinquency penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid by each
11		cosmetic art shop that does not pay the required fees by the February 1
12		deadline.
13	(10)	The fee for reissuance of an expired permit of a cosmetic art shop shall
14		be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)fifteen dollars (\$15.00).
15	(11)	All cosmetic art schools shall pay a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00)-thirty
16		dollars (\$30.00) annually.
17	(12)	Applicants for licensing under G.S. 88-19 shall pay an application fee
18		of fifteen dollars (\$15.00). ten dollars (\$10.00).
19	(13)	Registered cosmetologists licensed under G.S. 88-19 shall pay an
20		annual license fee of eleven dollars (\$11.00)-nine dollars (\$9.00) until
21		the year in which all other registered cosmetologist licenses are due for
22		renewal and then shall pay the fees required in subdivision (5) above.
23	(14)	A delinquency penalty of three dollars (\$3.00) two dollars (\$2.00) shall
24		be paid by all registered cosmetologists licensed under G.S. 88-19,
25		paying on an annual basis if they do not renew their license before
26		October 1 of that year.
27	(15)	Apprentice cosmetologists, licensed under G.S. 88-19, shall pay an
28		annual license fee of five dollars (\$5.00)-three dollars (\$3.00) for the
29		first year, or part of the year, in addition to the application fee required
30		by subdivision (12) above.
31	(16)	All cosmetic art teachers shall be licensed by the Board and shall pay a
32		fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) eight dollars (\$8.00) for that license which
33		shall be renewed every two years.
34	• •	Board shall not increase the fees set in subsection (a) of this section, but
35	-	y regulate the payment of the fees and may prorate the fees as
36	appropriate."	
37		2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to fees due after that
38	date.
